Jim – we need to discuss this further. I know we have discussed this in concept – but we have seen a specific plan. We are supportive of improving the trails, but I don't think we fully understand what the City intends with regards to boat launching and docking – and I think we discussed in the field our concerns and limitations we saw with this aspect of the project. I know you are rushing to complete your grant – but I do think State Parks needs to be a little clearer with the City's concept before we could support it.

We discussed concepts in the field – but you were going to get back with you management to further refine what the City wanted to do. Do you have any conceptual plans we could look at – either a narrative, graphic or both?
